Registration

- SSA's Annual Membership Fee is regularly \$50 per family, and is non-refundable.
- Sawnee School of the Arts requires a credit card to be on file in order to complete registration.
- Families new to SSA will automatically have the membership fee posted to their Jackrabbit account.
- Membership fees for returning SSA families will be posted to their Jackrabbit account shortly after registration has been received.

Tuition

- Tuition rates are calculated based on the total number of enrolled hours per week per family.
- Tuition installments are divided into **NINE** equal payments due on or before the 1st of each month August-May (no tuition installment for December as costume payments are due).
- December's pro-rated tuition is included in August or the first month's tuition installment for those that register (September November).
- Tuition remains the same whether it is a long or short lesson month and is always due even when the studio is closed (including holidays, breaks, and inclement weather). We guarantee 32 lessons per season, which allows for Fall, Thanksgiving, Winter and Spring Breaks in accordance with the Forsyth County School System.
- Monthly autopay is available or payment can also be made at any time through the Parent Portal. Parents
 who wish to pay with cash or check must do so on or before the 6th of each month. Tuition will be
 automatically deducted from the account on file on the 7th.
- If the credit card on file is declined on the 7th, a \$15 late fee will be added to the account. There is a \$25 charge for returned checks.

Recital

- SSA's Annual Recital is the Saturday of Memorial Day Weekend with dress rehearsals scheduled the Friday prior.
- Costume Fees are due on or before December 1st (see rates below). In the event that the recital format
 changes due to COVID-19 or any unforeseen event, SSA may forgo ordering recital costumes and Costume
 Fees would not be charged, or would remain as a credit on the SSA account.
- All paid Costume and Performance Fees are non-refundable.
- All costume fees paid by December 1st receive a \$10 discount.
- All accounts must be paid in full by May 7 in order for the dancer(s) to participate in the annual recital.

Other Fees

- All fees are due in full by the first of each month.
- There is a \$15 late fee for all past due accounts at end-of-business on the 7th of each month.
- There is a \$25 charge for returned checks.
- Students with accounts over 30 days past due will be suspended from class participation until the account is current.
- Private lessons:
 - o 30 or 60 minutes = \$15 studio rental fee + instructor rate
 - Availability is limited due to availability of instructors and studio space

Refunds/Credits

- All Membership, Tuition, Costume, and Performance fees are non-refundable.
- Classes missed due to illness will not be issued a refund or account credit. Makeup classes are available, but must be scheduled through the SSA front desk to ensure class limits are maintained.
- A refund or SSA account credit will be issued for classes canceled due to lack of enrollment.
